Parking: Parking is encouraged at the Weymouth Masonic Building located at 610 Broad

Street, Weymouth.

Staging: All units and groups will assemble near the Lawrence W. Pingree Elementary School

located at 1250 Commercial St., Weymouth.

Route: The parade will start at Jackson Square, proceed down Broad Street to Middle Street,

and conclude at the Ralph Talbot Amphitheater next to Weymouth Town Hall.

Distance: Approximately 1.25 miles

Vehicles: No vehicles are allowed on the route unless approved by Wor. George Raymond,

Master of Weymouth United Lodge.

Banners: All Brethren will march under the Grand Lodge of Massachusetts banner. Weymouth

United Lodge may carry their Lodge banner.

Transportation: Return transportation is limited. The parade will end less than 0.5 miles from the

Weymouth Lodge Building. If you need transportation, please contact Wor. George

Raymond.

Refreshments: The Master and Wardens of Weymouth United Masonic Lodge invite you to join

them following the parade at the Weymouth Masonic Building for refreshments.

The Parade Committee reminds us:

- All parade participants must arrive at the staging area <u>no later than 8:30 AM.</u> The parade will start at <u>10:15 AM SHARP</u> rain, snow or shine.
- Many of the roads on and around the parade route will be closed or may be redirected due to this event.
- Candy may not be thrown but is allowed to be handed out.
- Handing out flyers or any other promotional material is strictly prohibited
- Political statements or other expressions are strictly prohibited
